eNOTICE at a glance

5 years

Sep 1, 2017 – Aug 31, 2022

- **Networking** for Training Centres:
 - ❑ Practical **practitioner-centered** approach
 - ❑ **Interface** built with **stakeholders** (industries, SMEs, academia, policy-makers, civ and mil actors)
 - ❑ **Online Community Centre** (Catalogue of TC, dissemination, communication)
- **Finding and mapping** existing Training Centres – 202 TC found
- **Network Status** – 49 TC from 19 countries are in the network (eNOTICE questionnaire filled)
- ❑ **Joint Activities:** through pooling, sharing and optimising resources
 - ❑ Use TC **existing curriculum** to organize many **joint exercises** and invite **stakeholders** and **R&D project**
 - 12 consortium partners:
 - 8 countries
 - 7 civilian training centres
 - 3 military training centres

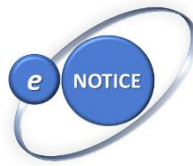

Benefits for training centers in joining the network

UNIQUE SELLING POINT : CBRN EXPERTISE + X INFRASTRUCTURE

Expected benefits for TC:

- To give TC visibility at EU level – to be known by EC, chosen and contacted in case needed for specific capability or cross-border training
- To get to know other TC, exchange practices, exchange trainers and trainees. Including exchanges with TC outside EU! (DG DEVCO centres)
- To find new trainees
- To give TC access to new markets through participation in and hosting activities of research projects => thus **creating new clients and beneficiaries**

TC ARE A NATURAL **OPERATIONAL** LINK BETWEEN ALL OTHER PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY STAKEHOLDERS

Collaboration with the EC (DG DEVCO CBRN CoE)

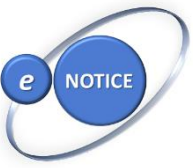
eNOTICE EU network is being extended to non-EU TCs part of EC initiatives, e.g. CBRN CoE or other civil protection or humanitarian initiatives.

Role of EC:

- identifying the TCs from non-EU countries,
- collecting information and descriptions of these TCs through the questionnaire developed by eNOTICE
- Publication of the generic infos on eNOTICE website – visibility for the whole community.

TCs from Tunisia, Uzbekistan, Burkina Faso joined the network

TC from Serbia, Montenegro, Bosnia, Albania, Georgia, Armenia, Ukraine, Moldova..

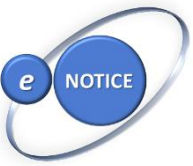
Advantage for eNOTICE EU TC:

- Access to the public information of EU CBRN TC of the network, potential partnerships for training

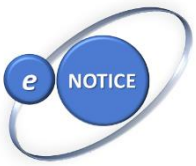
Collaboration with H2020 and ISF projects

- **PROACTIVE** – 3 eNOTICE Joint Activities (in Italy, Germany, Belgium) take place together with PROACTIVE as full participant

- ISF projects **BULLSEYE** and **MELODY** – exchanges of practice, experts for each others' events

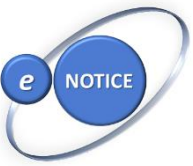

Challenges – sustainability and funding



Pre-requisites:

- Interest and enthusiasm of all partners and current members
- All eNOTICE resources in place:
 - Methodology for exercises preparation and reporting
 - KPIs for a successful network performance
 - Capacity label (label to describe TC speciality and facilities)
 - Fully functional eNOTICE Community Center
 - Joint Activities (field exercises, tabletops, simulations and serious gamings)
 - Collaboration with all key stakeholders – policy makers (EC, national), CoU, CBRN CoE, training professionals and practitioners from other networks and initiatives, technology suppliers and current CBRN R&D projects

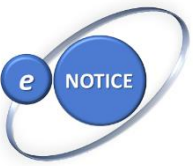
Challenge - Network continuation, funding, sustainability after August 2022!

Funding for the centralized management of the network – for tracking changes in contacts, organisation of meetings (virtual or physical), maintenance of joint activities

Possible solutions:

- Fee for membership in the network for training centers
- Fee for technology suppliers to participate in Network Member TCs' exercises and test technologies with practitioners
- Sponsorship of exercises by industry interested to test technologies in their sector
- Application for future suitable Horizon Europe calls (?)
- National funding for the centralized management (depending on the country)
- ... ??? sustainability framework under development
