The 2nd Policy-Research Dialogue Roundtable is an event jointly organized by DG HOME and the DRIVER+ project. It will build upon the outcomes of the Program Committee meeting (17 October 2019) and the Security Research Event (6-7 November 2019) with the aim to further debate and generate ideas in line of the ongoing strategic planning process of the EC (see for more details: [Orientations towards the first Strategic Plan implementing the research and innovation framework programme Horizon Europe](#)).

The PRDR-2 is specifically targeted towards generating inputs for the ongoing co-design process in relation to the priority ‘Disaster-resilient societies’ of the envisioned Horizon Europe cluster “Civil Security for Society”. The event will therefore focus on the needs and requirements for an improved capability development process regarding climate-related risks (wildfires and floods) as well as CBRN-E, that should be addressed in Horizon Europe and other Union programmes.

This will be done through a facilitated discussion about the key elements and timeline of a roadmap which is targeted towards an enhanced European capability development process in Disaster Risk Management. It will address the following key questions:

1. How can the future program for research and innovation improve the current capability development process by ensuring a better uptake of results from previous projects?
2. How can these elements be best implemented in the Horizon Europe Work Programme and other funding instruments?
3. How can the synergies between the Community of Users framework and the envisioned UCPM Knowledge Network be best exploited to enhance the European capability development process in Disaster Risk Management?

For this purpose DG HOME and the DRIVER+ project invite a broad range of policy representatives to jointly discuss the contributions to the programming of the DRS component of Horizon Europe. It covers DG ECHO, DG HOME, DG RTD, DG ENV, DG CLIMA, JRC, Member State representatives, Program Committee members, UNISDR, GFDRR as well as selected DRS-related research projects.
