Background

- Increasing globalisation, climate change, security threats growing in scale and sophistication
- Demand from european citizens to increase their security accordingly to these new stakes
- Crisis and disasters ignoring boundaries and plans
- Multi-Stakeholders crisis and disaster response (National, European and International level)
- Security: a market with strong growth perspectives
- EU specific challenges: open space with 28 member states responsible for security, 28 governments and different territorial organizations, 24 official languages.....
- Coordination needs and European investments to be focused on Users needs
- Standardisation is a lever but Pre-standardisation needs to be improved

Objectives and what role for standardization?

Objective 1: "Security" information exchange STAIR platform

IN: Single entry point for :

- Users (Policy makers, practitioners, Standardisers)
- Suppliers (Industry incl. SMEs)
- Researchers

OUT: coordinated and consulted input to

- FP9 research and pre-normative research topics
- Pre-standardization activities
- Standardization activities at European or International level (including to the AUWP and specific standardization request)

Objective 2: Standardization tools and mechanisms

Standardisation process

Improvement :

- Security stakeholders needs fit processes
- Involving all stakeholders, developing participation

Fast track adoption procedure to adopt

CWA, TR and TS as consensus standard (EN)

CEN-CENELEC Innovation Plan adopted during the General Assembly in June 2018

CEN-CENELEC Ambitions 2020 Action 5.2. 'Fast Track Approach'/Revision of CWA concept

STAIR4Security Platform in short

- ▶ STAIR Platform: only and permanent mechanism for Security Pre-Standardisation
- ▶ Focus: needs of security policy makers, managers and first responders. Suppliers and research needs are the ones of their customers.
- ▶ Identification and prioritization of the security users' needs in order to optimize security research investments
- ▶ Identification and assessment of Items or security research outcomes to be standardised

Type of grant & indicative Budget

- Grant to identified beneficiary - Coordination and support actions
- Indicative budget: **EUR 0.90 million** from the 2018 budget (Pre-standardisation mechanisms)

Timeline targeted

- Submission of the proposal – coordinated by CCMC - by end of September 2018.
 - Grant agreement to be signed by December 2018.
 - Official start of the H2020 action: 1st of January 2019.
- ▶ Duration: 24 months.
